### RAPID RE-HOUSING PROGRAM

*Services provided:*

- ◆ Assisted 21 adults and 29 kids on their journey of re-building life after abuse.
- ◆ Provides financial aid and assistance to qualified DV victims who wish to establish a stable home, free from abuse, for their family.
- ◆ Funded by the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

Promotes healing, safety, and resilience in the lives of children, youth, and adolescents who have experienced trauma through domestic violence.

# 26th Annual Beaman Home Golf Scramble

Since opening the emergency shelter in 1985, and serving thousands of victimized families, Beaman Home's programs and services have expanded to better meet the needs of victims living in Kosciusko, Fulton and Marshall Counties. Today, our continuum of services is designed to assist someone from the moment they realize they're in an unhealthy/unsafe relationship and reach out for help to the moment they feel they no longer need our services.

Beaman Home's Emergency Shelter and Crisis Hotline are available 24/7 to assist with crisis intervention and provide a victim with somewhere safe to go when they flee their abusive situation.

DoVE Outreach Program assists victims and survivors who are not residing in the shelter. These services include advocacy, case management, danger assessments & safety plans, assistance with protective order applications and more.

BeCoME Counseling Program provides one-on-one mental health counseling as well as therapeutic support groups to assist survivors in overcoming the emotional and mental effects of being victimized.

Family Life Skills Program – which includes Adult Life Skills Program and SYNC Up! Program – provides family focused services designed to help both adults and children overcome and heal from the traumatic effects of family violence.

Beaman's Basic Needs Center provides much needed items such as clothing, personal care items, household items, furniture, and more to survivors who are starting their life over after leaving their abusive relationship.
